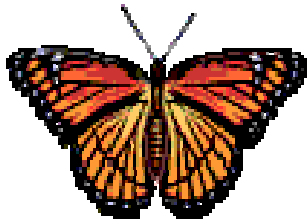

Permanent Make Up Frequently Asked Questions

What areas do you treat?

Eyebrows, eyeliner, full lips and liner. Beauty marks can be created.

Does it hurt?

No, because we use effective topical anesthetics. The needles used for the procedure are very fine (we use disposable needles for each treatment).

How long does it last?

Approximately 3 to 5 years but for some it can last much longer. Results can be more permanent if the skin is properly taken care of.

Who cannot get permanent make up?

Pregnant or nursing mothers, those with bleeding tendencies, certain health issues i.e. infectious diseases, allergies to dyes or anesthetics.

How do I know if I am allergic to the pigments?

To ensure there will be no problems, a **patch test** is performed at least 2 days prior to the procedure to ensure there are no allergies to the products used.

What can I expect after the procedure is done?

Generally you can expect mild redness, a little swelling, tenderness and itchiness for a few days (some individuals may bruise). You will be given a topical antibacterial ointment to use at home for a few days. Some flaking is common and the colour will fade a couple of shades. You may require a touch up at a future appointment.

What are possible complications?

Rarely do we see infection, scarring and loss of eyelashes (with eyeliner). Allergic reactions can occur to products used even if the patch test was normal.

How do I prepare the treatment?

On the day of the procedure, come in without makeup on and dressed comfortably. For eyebrows, sparse hair does not need to be removed. Avoid wearing contact lenses. Wear sunglasses after eyeliner treatments.

How long does the procedure take?

You may be here for a couple of hours in total. In the first hour we will apply the topical anesthetics (you can bring a book to read). The makeup application can take approximately one hour.

How much does it cost?

(This price includes 3 touch ups within the first 3 months of application)
